YOUNG VOICES

I have had an update from Young Voices on their Covid contingency. They are planning to go ahead (unless further restrictions are announced) with the following measures:

- all school adults will have taken a lateral flow test less than 24 hours before arriving
- all school adults will be asked to prove their Covid status (negative PCR test, double vaccine or Covid infection in the last 6 months)
- children will eat their food in their arena seats to avoid mixing between schools
- there will be extra cleaning of all touch points
- school adults will wear masks when moving around the venue
- audience members will be asked to prove their Covid status on arrival
- audience members will be asked to wear masks at all times
